Saturday 9th June Visit to Stenton Village.

Ray Halliday will lead a walk round this interesting village looking at its history; Bill Dodd will then take us into the churchyard and explain about the Old Kirk built in 1561 to replace an earlier kirk at Pitcox ; Stephen Bunyan will then take us into the present church.

This will be followed by tea in the Village Hall.

Saturday 7th July Visit to Doon Hill with Professor Ian Ralston.

Following his talk in March, Ian will show us round this important site, and explain recent thoughts on its place in history.

Doon Hill also played a major part in the 1650 battle of Dunbar; Arran Johnston will be there to explain what happened.

Directions: take turning, signposted Doon Hill, off A1, south of Dunbar. Follow road to next sign, where we will meet and organise car sharing. Parking is limited on the top.
